

DAILY MAINTENANCE OF CERALITE® PRODUCTS

CERALITE® composite sanitary ware do not require any particular maintenance. We use sanitary-grade gel coat with anti-UV treatment to preserve the beauty of the products over the years.

For daily maintenance a sponge and soapy water are sufficient. Rinse it off with lukewarm water. To preserve the polished surface, clean your tub with a microfiber cloth.

For weekly cleaning we recommend any liquid cleaner suitable for sanitary ware.

If you need to disinfect your bath, you can use a low-concentration bleach solution and then rinse immediately after.

As a general rule, wipe up any chemical spills as soon as possible to avoid potential stains.

SHINY SURFACE

- ▶ Use a glass cleaner to give your product a clean and shiny appearance.
- ▶ Remove lime and rust deposits with white vinegar (or an anti-lime such as Antikal) then rinse with clean water.
- ▶ Remove difficult stains with a stain remover and then rinse with clean water.
- ▶ Restore the gloss of tarnished surfaces with a car polish.

MATT SURFACE

- ▶ Do not use a cleaner containing wax or other ingredients intended for surface polishing.
- ▶ Remove lime and rust deposits with household vinegar, then rinse with clean water.
- ▶ Remove difficult stains with a sponge and stain remover.
- ▶ Stubborn marks and fine scratches can be removed with a Scotchbrite pad.



PRECAUTIONS FOR USE

- ▶ Do not let any liquid cleanser sit for long periods of time as this may stain the bath depending on the type of cleaning product.
- ▶ In all cases, the use of abrasive products that could damage your sanitary devices must be prohibited: scouring sponges, hard brushes, scouring powders or creams, etc.
- ▶ Do not use chemical unblockers or products containing caustic soda.
- ▶ Always run hot and cold water simultaneously in your tub or sink. Mixed water should not exceed 60°C.
- ▶ Never put in contact with a source of excessive heat (candle, cigarette, hair straightener).

PROBLEMS & SOLUTIONS

The table below details the effects and consequences of the main household products that can be used in a bathroom. These tests were performed at room temperature and under normal conditions of use.

COSMETICS	Lipstick	No effect.	Disappears when wiping with a soft cloth. Avoid moistening the trace.
	Nail polish	No effect.	Remove the mark with a damp sponge Use a soft cloth soaked in 90 ° alcohol.
	Varnish remover (acetone)	No immediate effect. Marks the product after prolonged contact.	Clean with a household cleaning product. Rinse with clean water.
	Hair gel or hairspray	No effect.	Clean with a household cleaning product. Rinse with clean water.
	Hair dye	Quickly marks the surface and leaves an indelible mark after prolonged contact.	Clean up immediately with synthetic thinner.
PHARMACY	Eosin antiseptic	No effect.	Clean with a household cleaning product. Rinse with clean water.
	Oxygenated water	No effect.	Clean with a household cleaning product. Rinse with clean water.
HOUSEHOLD PRODUCTS	Bleach (12% Chlorine)	No effect.	Rinse with clean water.
	Ajax powder	Can easily scratch the surface,	Polish with a soft cloth to remove micro-scratches.
	Anti-limescale type "Antikal"	No effect.	Rinse with clean water.
	Household alcohol	No effect.	Clean with a household cleaning product. Rinse with clean water.
